

Sales process and shipping rates

Sales process

This year, we have agreed with Taigh Chearsabagh that sale of work will be possible both in person (through card/cash sale) and online (through the TC webshop)

This means that:

- Works which can be replaced by the artist may be sold and delivered during the exhibition. All other work will be due for delivery at the end of the exhibition (August 16). Works will be automatically deleted from the shop when they are sold and artists will be emailed details of all sales
- If TC is forced to close due to Covid regulations and a physical exhibition is possible, buyers will still be directed to purchase work through the online shop. If this is a problem, buyers will be able to contact a UAA committee member for help
- Money will be collected by TC and UAA and artists will be paid at the end of the exhibition by TC (minus commission) on confirmation from the artist that the work has been delivered to the buyer
- Artists will be responsible for delivering their work to the buyer
- An estimated charge for postage and packing is automatically added by the website shop at the time of purchase (based on the rough size of the work and on where the package is to be sent). The rates used are based on current Parcelforce rates (<https://www.parcelforce.com/>) and are explained in the attached document.
- The postage added is an estimate and you may find that the actual cost is higher or lower. It will be your responsibility to negotiate any refund/additional payment with the buyer..
- If you would prefer to use your own estimate of postal costs (or to restrict the destination of sales), then please send us the figures and we will add them to your items in the shop

Shipping costs

For the TC online shop, we will charge the buyer an estimated shipping fee, based on the buyer's geographical location and on the size of your work. This estimate is based on advertised Royal Mail/Parcelforce charges.

The shipping charges will not be subject to the 25% commission charge on artwork sales.

Exact shipping rates will depend on the actual weight and size of your parcel and the courier used at the time of shipping, as determined by the local Post Office.

Alternatively, you can supply us with your own shipping rates (for each part of the world) and we will apply these to your products.

These are the shipping charges which will be applied to works in the exhibition unless the artist supplies their own rates
